

What: Authorization and funding for 2024-2031 EE programs

What's new:

- Intervenor Testimony (10/21)
 - □ Cal Advocates proposed SoCalREN program eliminations and reductions
- SoCalREN Rebuttal Testimony (11/21)
 REN Performance Metric: Total Community Benefit (TCB)
- Meet and Confer highlights remaining issues (12/1)

Focus is on Business Plan review



R.20-08-020 - NEM Net Billing Tariff

What: Tariff for customers who generate their own energy and receive credit for any surplus exported to the grid

What's new:

- <u>Revised Proposed Decision</u> proposes new tariff structure (11/10)
 - □ Reduces credit customers receive for exports to the grid
 - Additional credit adder for residential and low-income customers
 - Encourages solar + battery storage systems w/ 9-year payback

What's next:

• CPUC adoption of proposed decision (12/15)



R.18-12-006 – Vehicle Electrification

What: How CPUC will support increased electric vehicles

What's new:

- <u>D.22-11-040</u> adopts CA EV Framework
 - IOUs currently have \$1.4B in unspent EV program funding
 - □ \$1B for statewide BTM infrastructure rebate program
 - □ \$25M for low-income infrastructure rebate pilot

What's next:

- IOUs to exhaust unspent funding through 2026
- IOUs to set up rebate program and pilot

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
